





# Marine Insights

## **NAVIGATING HEAVY WEATHER AT SEA: ESSENTIAL SAFETY MEASURES**

Heavy weather poses significant challenges for ships at sea, and it is necessary to ensure the safety of the ship, crew, and cargo - with meticulous planning and coordinated actions across departments are essential.



#### General Precautions for All Ships

When heavy weather is anticipated, preparation begins with communication and bridge readiness. **Key actions** include notifying the Master, Chief Officer, and relevant departments, such as the Engine Room and Catering staff. The ship's bridge becomes the nerve center for monitoring and coordination, with the following measures taken:

- Activate navigation aids like the ARPA (Automatic Radar Plotting Aid) and turn on navigation lights for reduced visibility.
- $\bullet$  Engage the second steering motor and test sound signaling devices, including whistles and foghorns.
- Plan the safest possible route with attention to under-keel clearance, maneuverability challenges, and potential equipment failures like engine or steering malfunctions.

The Deck Department, under the Chief Officer's supervision, is responsible for securing the ship's exterior and cargo areas. Essential actions include checking anchor lashings, sealing forepeak store hatches, and stowing mooring ropes securely.

Loose objects on the deck, such as oil drums or painting rafts, are lashed securely to prevent shifts. Lifeboats must be inspected, ensuring gripes are tight and locking pins are in place without additional lashings that could hinder emergency deployment. All weather-tight doors and portholes near the waterline are closed, with deadlights secured where available.

#### Cargo Ships, Tankers: Tailored Preparations

For cargo ships, the focus is on safeguarding cargo and securing hatches. Lashings for both on-deck and below-deck cargo are tightened. Hatch covers are checked, and wedges are reinforced to ensure watertight integrity.

Derrick heads and associated gear are secured to prevent accidental unshipping due to slamming forces, while ventilator cowls are adjusted or removed in extreme conditions, with coamings sealed for protection. Lifelines are rigged on both sides of the upper deck to ensure safe passage for crew, regardless of wind direction or ship orientation.

All tank openings, including lids, sighting ports, and ullage ports, are sealed to prevent seawater ingress and oil splashing onto the deck during rolling.

The ship's low freeboard makes tankers susceptible to waves washing over the deck. A central walkway, or catwalk, is used to ensure safe passage between accommodation areas and the ship's forward sections, eliminating the need for lifelines. Additionally, heavy weather ballast tanks are prepared according to MARPOL regulations to enhance stability.

The **Engine Department** ensures machinery remains operational and secure. Engine Room skylights, if not permanently sealed, are closed, and all tools, spares, and equipment are secured.

Operationally, oil tank levels are checked to prevent pumps from losing suction during rolling, and the engine governor is adjusted to control RPM surges caused by pitching. As a precaution, a second generator may be started in parallel to handle potential power interruptions.

Heavy weather demands readiness, vigilance, and teamwork. Each department plays a critical role in ensuring the ship remains safe and operational. From securing cargo and equipment to adapting routines in the galley and engine room, these measures are designed to mitigate risks and protect lives and assets.

By preparing thoroughly, maintaining clear communication, and responding pro-actively to the challenges of heavy seas, seafarers can ensure a safer voyage, even when the weather is at its worst.

# MARITIME SYMPOSIUM 2024 LENDS ZEAL TO INDIA'S 2030 GOALS – 'MAKING INDIA A GREAT MARITIME NATION'

Sweden's World Maritime University joined hands with the Nautical Institute and the Indian Shipbroker's Association – Mumbai Branch, officially inaugurating the World Maritime University Indian Alumni Association on the 14th of November 2024. In the spirit of new beginnings, a seminar on 'Making India A Great Maritime Nation' was conducted at the Indian Register Of Shipping in Mumbai. The Chief Guest for the day was the Consulate General Of Sweden In India – Mr. Sven Östberg. Capt. BK Tyagi, Chairman and Managing Director of Shipping Corporation Of India and Shri Arun Sharma, Executive Chairman of Indian Register Of Shipping were the guests of honor.

The event began with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp by the chief guests and guests of honor, followed by an inspiring speech by the chief guest Mr. Sven Östberg. Mr. Sven Östberg drew on his twenty-five-year experience working in the trade domain of foreign relations and emphasized on the bright and prosperous future that awaits the maritime industry in India. Capt. BK Tyagi took to stage, continuing the optimistic spirit – stressing on the untapped reservoir of talent that India has and can use towards a glorious future and lauding the brilliance of the collaborations of the three institutes. This was followed by an enrapturing speech

by Shri Arun Sharma who enunciated the role played by education and awareness in the acceleration of growth in maritime trade. Speakers from the three stellar institutes — World Maritime University, Nautical Institute & Indian Shipbroker's Association gave informative reports and awe-inspiring projections of India's Maritime present and future, urging the audience to do better — reaching out for ideals of responsibility, safety and sustainability.

# BEYOND FUELS AND TECHNOLOGY: THE HUMAN ELEMENT IN MARITIME DECARBONIZATION

he maritime industry is at a pivotal moment in its decarbonisation journey. Over the past decade, the sector has transitioned from focusing solely on-air pollutants like sulphur oxides to adopting comprehensive strategies for reducing greenhouse gas emissions. This evolution presents both significant challenges and transformative opportunities for stakeholders across the globe.

When the Energy Efficiency Design Index (EEDI) and Ship Energy Efficiency Management Plan (SEEMP) were introduced in 2013, they did more than establish new global benchmarks. They catalyzed a shift in the industry's approach to energy efficiency, laying the groundwork for operational performance measures like the Carbon Intensity Indicator (CII) and an increased focus on GHG emissions reduction for the sector using alternative fuels and innovative technologies. The introduction of regional regulations such as the EU's maritime requirements, which could affect up to 30 per cent of the global fleet, have sharpened that focus.

Amid this focus, the critical role of the human element often remains underappreciated. Yet, it is clear that the success of maritime decarbonization efforts depends not just on fuels, innovative energy systems and technological solutions, but also on the actions of shore staff and seafarers. These professionals are not merely operators of new systems – they are the key enablers of the industry's sustainable future. Their decisions, from route planning to fuel management, determine whether advanced technologies achieve their full potential or fall short.

This human-centric reality demands a fundamental shift in approach. Training must evolve from basic operational competencies to fostering a deep understanding of the systems they have to manage and energy efficiency principles. Shore teams need advanced skills to analyze complex performance data and optimize vessel operations, while seafarers require knowledge to align everyday practices with emissions goals. Most importantly, the industry must cultivate a culture where environmental protection becomes as integral to operations as safety awareness.

Leadership plays a pivotal role in driving this transformation. Maritime executives must champion an organizational ethos that



integrates environmental considerations into decision-making. This includes incentivizing energy-efficient practices, fostering collaboration between ship and shore teams, and embedding environmental performance as a core metric of operational excellence.

However, balancing regulatory compliance with operational realities remains a pressing challenge. For instance, fuel wasted by ships awaiting berth availability highlights inefficiencies that undermine sustainability efforts. The industry's response, such as the International Maritime Organization's (IMO) mandated Single Maritime Window for streamlined data exchange, exemplifies how digitalization can address such issues. Similarly, Singapore's upcoming requirement for electronic Bunker Delivery Notes underscores the shift toward digital solutions in emissions monitoring and compliance.

Looking ahead, maritime GHG emissions pricing mechanisms will play a vital role in bridging the cost gap between traditional and green fuels. To be effective, these mechanisms must provide an enabling pathway, with funds allocated to incentivize green fuel adoption and mitigate investment risks for shipowners and fuel producers. The fundamental shift for shipping from Tank-to-Wake to Well-to-Wake compliance further underscores the need for advanced digital tools, including artificial intelligence, to navigate regulatory complexities.

The path to maritime decarbonization hinges on unprecedented collaboration. Sharing information across industry actors will enhance risk management and inform investment decisions, especially as the finalization of IMO's mid-term regulatory measures approaches.

Resources like The International Chamber of Shipping's 'Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions: A Guide to International Regulatory Compliance, Second Edition' offer invaluable guidance for navigating these challenges, providing stakeholders with actionable insights and a clear roadmap.

The journey toward decarbonization is not merely about compliance – it's about building a sustainable, efficient future for shipping. Success will depend on the sector's ability to adapt, innovate, and collaborate, transforming challenges into opportunities for growth and environmental stewardship.

# ON WHOSE BEHALF IS THE LOI GIVEN? CONSIDERATIONS FOR CHARTERERS WHEN ISSUING AND RECEIVING LOIS

etters of Indemnity ("LOI") are often used to facilitate efficient trade. For instance, when the bills of lading have not arrived at the discharge port in time, and the vessel would otherwise have to wait accruing demurrage, or where the place of delivery under the sales contract differs from the discharge port named in the bills of lading.

However, liability in these instances will fall outside of P&I cover due to the exclusions for cargo cover and because the undertakings provided under the LOI are generally onerous.

Therefore, owners and charterers will seek to rely on an indemnity from the party below them in the contractual chain making the request to cover these risks, and they will be reliant on them having sufficient means to meet their obligations under the LOI. In the case of mis-delivery, the claims can be significant and may exceed the value of the cargo.

A recent decision of the English High Court confirms that, unless they are acting as an agent for an "undisclosed principal", only the entity issuing the LOI will be liable under the LOI even if they are a part of a wider group of companies.

An "undisclosed principal" in English law arises when one enters a contract on behalf of another without disclosing this to the other party. The agent and principal must consent, but consent will be based on an objective analysis of their words and conduct and can be express or implied, even if they do not recognise it as an agent/principal relationship themselves.

Therefore, when giving a LOI, charterers should carefully consider whether other entities in their own group could inadvertently be liable under the LOI and, when receiving a LOI from a party down the chain, charterers should consider whether the entity

providing the LOI (and not just the wider group of companies) has the financial means to meet its obligations.

When could another party be an "undisclosed principal" to a LOI?

This will depend on the facts of each case but the English High Court in Yangtze Navigation (Asia) Co Limited v TPT Shipping Limited provides some guidance on what the courts may consider.

Yangtze Navigation concerned three shipments of logs from New Zealand to India in 2020, which were discharged against a chain of LOIs for discharge without presentation of bills of lading. The cargo was alleged to have been misdelivered, and claims were brought against the vessel owners. The owners sought to rely on the LOIs provided by charterers, but the charterers were unable to recover under the LOI they received from receivers and were put into liquidation. Faced with the prospect of having no recourse for the misdelivery claims, the owners commenced proceedings against another company in the same group as the charterer (the "Affiliate") and the exporters of the cargo (the "Exporters"), alleging that they were ultimately liable under the LOI because the charterer had been acting as their agent and issued the LOIs on their behalf.

When deciding that the Affiliate and Exporters were not "undisclosed principals" and thus liable under the LOIs, the court considered:

 The contracts between the Charterers, the Affiliate and the Exporters: the Affiliate had a contract with the Exporters under which it would act as the Exporters' agent in marketing, selling and arranging shipment of their logs. As the Exporters' agent, the Affiliate contracted with the Charterer for the provision of shipping services for the logs.

- The structure of the group to which the Affiliate and Charterer belonged: the Charterer was established to insulate the rest of the group from the risks of chartering vessels. If the Charterer was only acting as the Affiliate's agent when chartering vessels and issuing LOIs, this would defeat the purpose of separating the Chartering business.
- How the shipments were arranged: the Charterer did not charter vessels for specific shipments. The Exporters only used space on the chartered vessels and Charterers could use any excess space as they wished, which would be contrary to the Charterers acting only as an agent for the Affiliate or Exporter when chartering vessels.
- Whether the Charterer made money on the shipments: all income and expenditure under the charterparties flowed to and from the Charterer and Exporters through the Affiliate, and the Charterer made no money on the shipments. It had previously been held by the English High Court that it was "perfectly possible" for two parties acting as principals to agree that one would make a ship available to the other in return for the reimbursement of all operating costs and without a profit and the Judge in Yangtze Shipping also did not consider that this meant that the Charterer was only acting as an agent when chartering vessels or issuing LOIs.

. The procedure for issuing LOIs: the Charterer sought the

Affiliate's approval before issuing the LOIs, but this did not necessarily mean that the Affiliate was an undisclosed principal to the LOI because it was to be expected that the Charterer would request the Affiliate's approval before allowing discharge against LOIs when the cargo was the Affiliate's security for payment. The Affiliate was required to obtain approval from the Exporters for discharge against LOI if acting as their agent but had not done so on these occasions. Therefore, if the Affiliate was acting as the Exporters' agent in approving the LOIs, they had done so without authority, but this would not make the Exporters liable to the owner under the LOI.

#### Conclusion

Many charterers separate their chartering business from other sides of their business, and in Yangtze Navigation, the English courts have again confirmed that this division will be upheld so long as the chartering business is not acting as an agent for other companies in the group.

Therefore, when receiving a LOI, the presumption is that only the entity issuing the LOI will be liable and not any other company in the same group. If there is any uncertainty as to the financial standing of the entity, Charterers may wish to consider asking that the LOI is counter-signed by a first-class bank or that an undertaking is provided by the parent company.



Sharing a post on X (December 9, 2024), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) of Russia quoted Kremlin spokesperson Dmitry Peskov and wrote, "We have carefully read the statement by US President-elect Donald Trump, made after his meeting with Mr. Macron and Mr. Zelensky in Paris.

Russia is open to negotiations on Ukraine and welcomes peace initiatives. The conditions required to cease the hostilities were laid out by President Putin.

"Notably, Trump on December 7 met Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy and French President Emmanuel Macron in Paris during the reopening of the Notre Dame Cathedral, which was severely damaged in the devastating 2019 fire. After the meeting, Mr. Trump in a post on his Truth Social platform, said, "There should be an immediate ceasefire and negotiations should begin. Too many lives are being needlessly wasted, too many families destroyed."

The Kremlin statement further stressed that President Putin has repeatedly said Russia was open to negotiations on Ukraine and welcomed peace initiatives, "primarily those coming from countries of the Global South, as well as our BRICS partners, including China, Brazil, and South Africa, and the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, and Saudi Arabia, which are engaged in work on the humanitarian track.

Peskov also highlighted Ukraine's "rejection" of negotiations, accusing President Volodymyr Zelenskyy of blocking dialogue with Moscow through a decree. "Our stance on Ukraine is well known. The conditions required to cease the hostilities immediately were laid out by President Putin in June this year in his speech at Russia's Foreign Ministry," the statement said.

It added, "What bears reminding here is that it was Ukraine that rejected negotiations, and the country still rejects them. Moreover, Zelensky has, by his own decree, banned himself and his presidential office from making any engagements with the Russian leadership. This particular stance of theirs remains unchanged. Yet, all Mr. Zelensky has to do to enter a trajectory of peace is to revoke this decree and issue an order to resume dialogue on the basis of arrangements made in Istanbul and with account taken of the realities taking shape on the ground. "Notably, the Russia-Ukraine conflict, which began in 2014 with Russia's annexation of Crimea, escalated into a full-scale war in February 2022 when Russia launched a large-scale military invasion of Ukraine.

# EU SHARES WITH INDIA INPUTS ON INDIAN ENTITIES MAKING SUPPLIES TO RUSSIA IN 'VIOLATION' OF G7 SANCTIONS

U Sanctions Envoy David O'Sullivan said he visited India in October to discuss with Indian authorities "systemic solutions" to stop the "illicit flow" of the common high priority items to Russia.

There was no immediate comment from the Indian side on the matter. India has been maintaining that as a matter of policy, it only recognises UN sanctions.

"I travelled to India in October 2024 for the second time to discuss with Indian authorities systemic solutions to stop the illicit flow of common high priority items to Russia," O'Sullivan said in response to a query.

It is learnt that he provided certain details to the Indian authorities about the Indian firms allegedly supplying

products to Russia circumventing the sanctions imposed by G7 and EU sanctions on Moscow.

The alleged violations by the Indian entities came to light after Washington imposed sanctions on 19 private firms from India for their alleged role in providing "dual-use" technologies to Russia.

EU sources said two entities based in India are subject to "specific export restrictions".

It is understood that India has sought more information from the EU on the matter.

"Several third countries I visited have put in place specific mechanisms to solve this issue. Russia's brutal and illegal invasion of Ukraine is existential for the EU," O'Sullivan said.

"We will continue to disrupt the activities of the Russian military industrial complex by shutting down illicit procurement networks on a constant basis," he said.

The EU sanctions envoy said his job is to make it "harder, slower and more expensive for Russia to access our technology".

"Data at our disposal shows that we are succeeding. We estimate that Russia is paying about 130 per cent more for semiconductors and 300 per cent more for second-hand machine tools after we imposed sanctions," he added.

The EU will continue to work with Indian authorities to find a systemic solution to stop sanctions circumvention of common high priority goods to Russia, the EU sources said.

"The EU is currently negotiating its 15th package of sanctions against Russia. This package will consist of listing of vessels part of the shadow fleet and entities that have been supplying 'battlefield items' to Russia," said an EU source.

These items are used to make Russian military equipment more precise and therefore more lethal, it said.

"The EU already listed hundreds of entities part of the Russian military industrial complex as well as actors based in third countries that have been actively undermining the EU sanctions framework," it said.

# ISRAEL TARGETS SYRIA: 480 STRIKES IN 48 HOURS AFTER ASSAD'S OUSTER

he Israeli military announced that it conducted approximately 480 airstrikes over the past 48 hours, targeting key military installations across Syria.

This escalation comes days after the removal of President Bashar al-Assad from power.

"Within the last 48 hours, the IDF (Israel Defense Forces) struck most of the strategic weapon's stockpiles in Syria, preventing them from falling into the hands of terrorist elements," the Israeli military said.

The strikes reportedly destroyed naval vessels, anti-aircraft systems, and weapons production sites across major cities, including Damascus, Homs, Tartus, Latakia, and Palmyra.

According to the IDF, 350 of the strikes involved manned aircraft targeting critical assets such as airfields, drones, missiles, tanks, and fighter jets. The remaining strikes supported ground operations, focusing on weapons depots, launchers, and firing positions. Additionally, Israeli naval

forces hit two Syrian naval facilities, destroying 15 docked vessels and sea-to-sea missile stockpiles.

The strikes come amidst a broader regional shift, with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu describing Assad's ouster as a turning point. "The collapse of the Syrian regime is a direct result of the severe blows with which we have struck Hamas, Hezbollah, and Iran," Netanyahu said during a press conference. "As I promised, we are changing the face of the Middle East."

Israeli leaders have expressed concern about the uncertainty following Assad's downfall. While celebrating the removal of an ally of Iran and Hezbollah, officials worry about the potential rise of radical Islamist factions governing Syria.

Foreign minister Gideon Sa'ar emphasized the importance of immediate action to safeguard Israel's security. "We are targeting military facilities housing chemical weapons and long-range missiles to prevent them from falling into the hands of extremists," he said.

# EX-SOUTH KOREA DEFENCE MINISTER KIM YONG-HYUN ACCUSED OF ROLE IN MARTIAL LAW TRIES TO COMMIT SUICIDE

outh Korean defense minister Kim Yong-Hyun, who was accused of involvement in a failed martial law attempt, attempted suicide on Wednesday.

"South Korea ex-defense minister Kim tried to commit suicide at detention center," Reuters quoted officials as saying.

This development follows the recent arrest of the former defence minister by South Korean prosecutors, who were investigating alleged treason after President Yoon Suk Yeol's martial law implementation.

Kim, who had resigned from his position, played a key role in the temporary martial law implementation. Documents from opposition members and information from a senior military official indicate that Kim had proposed this measure to Yoon.

Earlier in the day, a special police investigation unit in South Korea conducted a raid on the presidential office following President Yoon Suk Yeol's short-lived martial law declaration that caused nationwide turmoil.

"The Special Investigation Team has conducted a raid on the presidential office, the National Police Agency, the Seoul Metropolitan Police Agency, and the National Assembly Security Service," the unit stated in a message sent to AFP.
