GUIDANCE ON MARITIME CLAIMS

(In continuation to the article of 1st August, Issue)

POLLUTION CLAIMS

1.1 Introduction

Pollution is a major cause for concern and the regime of international and national laws that regulate it reflects that concern. Historically, anti-pollution legislation has been directed in the main towards pollution caused by the escape of oil carried as cargo. However, in more recent years, attention has also been given to other forms of pollution. Therefore, there are international conventions and local laws which regulate pollution from ship's bunkers and other hazardous and noxious substances (such as chemicals, gases and other volatile products), garbage and other waste, and even ships which are committed for recycling.

Pollution can give rise to both substantial civil liabilities and severe criminal sanctions and penalties and the legislative regime that governs pollution tends to fall into two categories:

- Pollution prevention; and
- · Liability for pollution.

1.2 Pollution Prevention

There is a body of international conventions that are designed to monitor ship structures and quality control systems, the aim of much of which is to minimise the risk of pollution. There are also similar pollution avoidance measures that regulate ship operation and there is a further body of international conventions that are designed to monitor the training of on-board personnel, the adequacy of on board and land-based pollution emergency plans and management systems linking on board and shore-based personnel.

Compliance with such regulations is enforced by a worldwide system of port state control whereby ships are required to carry compliance certificates that are regularly checked by port authorities at the ports visited by ships. Such authorities are also given the right to inspect the ship, to detain the ship if needs be and also require repairs to be carried out before the ship is allowed to leave. A finding of noncompliance can give rise to criminal sanctions such as the imposition of substantial fines and possibly restrictions on the ship's ability to trade freely. Therefore, non-compliance may also have commercial repercussions including the possible voidance of the ship's insurance cover.

Finally, a coastal state is entitled to take unilateral action to avoid or minimise a pollution threat. Such action is likely to arise if that state believes that the ship's personnel are either not acting to avoid or minimise the risk or are not doing so sufficiently promptly

Not all countries are parties to the various international conventions. Nevertheless, most coastal countries which are not parties to such international conventions tend to have local statutes which impose similar requirements and/or sanctions.

1.3 Pollution Response

Broadly speaking, there are two different types of pollution response regimes. The first is where the affected state takes responsibility for organising and initially paying for the response, although the state will almost certainly seek to recover its expenditure from

the responsible shipowner subsequently. The second is where the state requires the shipowner to organise and pay for the response. This is usually done through legislation stipulating that, as a condition of entry to a particular state's waters, the shipowner must have 'pre-contracted' with a company deemed suitable by the relevant state by virtue of having the equipment and competence necessary to respond to an oil spill.

1.3.1 State organised Response

Many states take the view that, in the event of a pollution incident, they are best placed to take tactical and strategic decisions as to how and with what personnel and equipment they should respond. To do so, many states will either employ directly, or have available under a standing contract, personnel and equipment, sited at strategic locations. Such an arrangement will, inter alia, enable those states to decide quickly whether dispersant should be used as part of the 'at sea' response, or whether any particular sites/areas that are or may become affected by the spill should be protected as a matter of priority. Such sites might be power stations or mariculture sites, or areas deemed to have outstanding natural beauty, or to be of historical or cultural importance. The reasoning behind such an approach is that it is only that state that will be aware of these factors and only that state that can make the sometimes-difficult decision as to which resource(s) should be given priority.

1.3.2 Shipowner organised Response

A number of states, of which the US is probably the best example, have adopted the view that the responsibility for spill response should rest with the 'responsible party' – almost always the shipowner. Recognising that it is extremely difficult for an owner to organise an effective spill response 'from scratch', these states require the owners of the ships calling at ports or places in that state to have entered into contractual arrangements with recognised and approved spill responders. These responders are called OSROs (Oil Spill Response Organisations) in the US. In China, where similar legislation is in place, they are called SPROs (Spill Response Organisations). In such states, it is the shipowner who is responsible for notifying the relevant authorities of the incident and for instructing the spill response organisation with which he has contracted to attend immediately. The contract between the shipowner and the response organisation will normally contain details of the number of personnel and type of equipment that will be called out in any particular incident and will depend largely on the amount and type of pollutant spilled. The contract will also normally contain a time limit in which the response must be put into effect.

It is normal for such response organisations to be vetted by the relevant state authority prior to their being approved and prior to their being allowed to enter into contracts with shipowners. Usually, they are graded (level 1, level 2 etc.) depending on the number of personnel and amount and type of equipment available.

However, this scheme may prove to have a deficiency if the pollution originates from a vessel that is not due to call at a port or place in the affected country and therefore, does not have such a contractual arrangement in place.





NEWS UPDATE FOR ONBOARD CREW

AT LEAST 22 KILLED AFTER HAVING IDS CHECKED IN PAKISTAN



unmen have killed at least 22 people in south-west Pakistan after forcing them out of their vehicles and checking their identity, officials say.

The attack happened overnight on a highway in Balochistan province, where security forces are battling sectarian, ethnic and separatist violence.

The armed men checked identity documents, reportedly singling out those from Punjab to be shot, before setting the vehicles alight, officials alleged.

The Baloch Liberation Army (BLA), a militant group, has said it was behind the attacks in Musa Khel district.

Interior Minister Mohsin Naqvi said that security forces had killed 12 militants in operations after the attacks, but did not give further details.

Over the past 24 hours, the BLA has launched a series of attacks on multiple government installations - including police stations and security forces' camps across province.

In Kalat, 11 were killed - five of them security personnel - and six bodies were recovered in another district in Balochistan.

According to Najibullah Kakar, a senior local official, around 30 to 40 militants were involved in Musa Khel.

"They stopped 22 vehicles," he told AFP news agency. "Vehicles traveling to and from Punjab were inspected, and individuals from Punjab were identified and shot."

The BLA has said it was targeting military personnel travelling in civilian clothes, according to news agency Reuters.

Before the attack, the BLA warned the Baloch public to stay away from the highway, adding that their "fight is against the occupying Pakistani military".

"We have taken full control of all major highways across Balochistan, blocking them completely," it added.

Mohsin Naqvi, the interior minister, said the attacks were "a well-thought out plan to create anarchy in Pakistan".

Prime Minister, Shehbaz Sharif expressed "deep grief and condemnation over the terrorist attack" in a statement issued by his office.

Balochistan is Pakistan's largest province but, although it has more resources than other provinces, it is the least developed.

The BLA and other Baloch separatists have intensified attacks on Punjabis and Sinhdis from elsewhere in Pakistan working in the region. They have also targeted foreign energy firms they accuse of exploiting the region without sharing profits.

In a similar incident in April this year, nine passengers were offloaded from a bus in Balochistan and shot dead after their IDs were checked.

Several Western countries, including the UK and US, have designated the BLA as a global terrorist organisation.

THE INDIAN ARCHER WITHOUT ARMS SHOOTING FOR A GOLD

rcher, Sheetal Devi picks up her bow, loads an arrow and carefully aims at her target, about 50m (164ft) away, with a look of immense focus on her face.

So does her opponent, who is playing a practice game with her at a training academy in India.

The difference is that Devi is seated on a chair. She raises the bow with her right leg, pulls back the string using her right shoulder and releases the arrow using the strength of her jaw.

What never changes throughout this process is Devi's calm demeanour.

The 17-year-old from Jammu district was born with phocomelia, a rare congenital disorder, making her one of the few female archers to compete without arms.

The Asian Para Games gold medallist is now gearing up for the Paralympics, which begin on 28th August in Paris.

"I am inspired to win the gold," Devi said. "Whenever I see the medals I have won [until now], I feel inspired to win more. I have just started."

Around 4,400 athletes from across the world will take part in 22

sports at the Paralympics this year.

Archery has been a part of the Games since the inaugural edition in 1960. While countries such as Great Britain, USA and South Korea have dominated the medal count, India has accounted for a solitary bronze medal across 17 editions.

Para-archers are grouped into categories depending on the severity of their impairment.

The distances they have to shoot also differ based on the classification system, which then determines whether an archer can use assistive devices such as wheelchairs and release aids.

Archers competing in the W1 category are wheelchair users with impairment in at least three out of the four limbs with either a clear loss of muscle strength, coordination or range of movement.

Those competing in the open category have an impairment in either the top or bottom half or one side of their bodies and use a wheelchair, or have a balance impairment and shoot standing or resting on a stool. Competitors use either recurve or compound bows, depending on the event.

Devi is currently ranked first in the world in the compound open women's category.

In 2023, she won a silver at the Para-Archery World Championship, which helped her qualify for the Paris Games.

At Paris, she will face tough competition from opponents including world number three Jane Karla Gogel and the reigning World Championship winner Oznur Cure.

But those who know her say she was destined to play the sport and

"Sheetal [Devi] did not choose archery, archery chose Sheetal," says Abhilasha Chaudhary, one of Devi's two national coaches. Born in a small village to a farming family, Devi had not seen a bow and arrow till she was 15.

The turning point came in 2022 when she visited the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board sports complex in Jammu's Katra about 200km (124 miles) from home - on the recommendation of an acquaintance.

There, she met Chaudhary and her other coach, Kuldeep Vedwan, who introduced her to the world of archery. She soon shifted to a training camp in Katra city.

The coaches said they were fascinated by Devi's grit.

The challenge was monumental, but their vision to make the most of the strength in Devi's legs and upper body eventually prevailed. Devi said the strength came from years of using her feet for most activities, including writing and climbing trees with her friends.

Yet, her decision to try a career in archery did not come without its doubts.

"I felt this was impossible," she said. "My legs used to ache a lot but somehow I did it."

In her low moments, Devi would take inspiration from American archer Matt Stutzman, who famously shoots with his feet using a customised device.

Devi's family could not afford a similar machine, so her coach Vedwan took it upon himself to create a bow for her.

He used locally-sourced materials and customised it as per her

needs at a local forge shop.

The gear includes an upper-body strap made from materials used in bag belts and a small instrument which Devi holds in her mouth to help release the arrow.

The real challenge, however, was to figure out how to use more than just her legs to form a well-rounded, sustainable technique.

"We had to manage how to balance the strength in her legs, modify it and use it technically," Chaudhary explains. "Devi has strong legs but we had to figure out how she would use her back to shoot.'

The trio then committed to a measured training routine, which began with Devi using a rubber band or TheraBand instead of a bow, to aim at targets placed at just a 5m distance.

As her confidence grew, so did the level of difficulty, and within just four months of starting out, she began to use a proper bow and hit targets at a 50m distance, the competition standard for the compound open category.

Within just two years, Devi went from learning to simply shoot an arrow at small distances to hitting six 10s in a row in the final of the women's individual compound event at the Asian Para Games in 2023 to win the gold medal.

For context, 10 is the maximum number of points a player can win for a single shot by hitting the bullseye on the target board.

"Even when I shoot a nine, I'm only thinking about how I can convert that into a 10 on the next shot," Devi said.

It's not just about hard work - there were also sacrifices along the

Devi said she hasn't gone home even once since she moved to Katra two years ago to train.

She now plans to return only after the Paralympics end, "hopefully with a medal".

Either way, she is determined to give her best shot.

"I believe that no one has any limitations, it's just about wanting something enough and working as hard as you can," she said.

TESLA'S OPTIMUS FACES STIFF HUMANOID COMPETITION AT BEIJING ROBOT CONFERENCE

hile Chinese companies last week showed off humanlike robots playing the zither or grabbing sodas, Tesla displayed its Optimus humanoid inside a clear box, motionless next to its cars.

Elon Musk has claimed Optimus can fold laundry, and one day cook, clean or teach children — tech he touts can give Tesla a value of \$25 trillion. Musk says Tesla plans to test out the humanoids in its factories next year. It's unclear how well they can perform right

Meanwhile, the World Robot Conference that began in Beijing claimed 27 humanoids debuted at the event, a record. Similar to the country's rush into electric cars a few years ago, money and resources are now flowing into the development of humanlike robots.

Total investment into China's robotics industry in the last decade has exceeded 100 billion yuan (\$14.01 billion), said Wei Cao, Partner at Lanchi Ventures. He said the firm has around 15 billion to 20 billion yuan in assets under management.

Cao told CNBC he expects the next milestone for humanoid

development will occur in the next year or two: a commercially viable use case in manufacturing in which the robots can move around and know how to prioritize a series of tasks.

That's more sophisticated than repeating a single task, such as grabbing a water bottle, which the robots can already do, Cao pointed out. He noted how artificial intelligence, including such as models from OpenAI and Alibaba, has significantly improved how successful robots can be at processing information for performing tasks.

Lanchi Ventures is an investor in Shanghai-based Agibot, a humanoid startup founded in February 2023 by a one-time Huawei recruit. A few days before the World Robot Conference, the startup revealed five new robots, some available for preorder with a 5,000 yuan deposit.

Agibot aims to begin some deliveries in mid-October, followed by a batch of 300 robots starting in November. Its advertisement for the available humanlike robots showed they could act as sales people, gallery guides or pickers of factory parts. Some were on display at the conference. B

Also in attendance was Stardust Intelligence's Astribot S1 humanlike robot, which in late April had appeared in a promotional video folding a shirt and pouring wine. A few of the robots on display at the conference performed intricate Chinese martial arts moves, played the zither and wrote Chinese brush calligraphy. Shenzhen-based Stardust was founded in December 2022 by a former member of Tencent and Baidu's robotics projects. The startup says it uses artificial intelligence to support the robots' imitation learning, where the machines can replicate actions after watching them.

Other humanlike robots, from lesser-known companies Galbot and Turui, put products into baskets or brought individual soda cans from a shelf to another table. Some of the actions were stiff and slow. It's not always clear whether the actions are being remotely controlled, or done autonomously. Demos don't reveal everything about a product's capabilities.

Compared to last year, the number and kinds of demos at the World Robot Conference increased significantly, Lanchi's Cao said, noting that many students and young people also attended.

In his assessment, robot tech from Tesla and other U.S. companies are likely one to two years ahead of that in China. But Cao pointed out that China has self-sufficiency in more than 95% of the humanoid supply chain. As for why Tesla didn't showcase Optimus in action at the conference, Cao said the promo videos already show it has high capabilities and he understands if the company did not want to invest resources in having an engineer to operate demos. Tesla did not immediately respond to a request for comment.

Jeff Burnstein, President of the U.S. Association for Advancing Automation (A3), spoke at the conference via a recorded video and showed some virtual demonstrations of humanoid startups such as Agility.

"These are demos, but they as well as others are now in pilot programs, and some companies we believe actually started using them more than just a pilot," he said, noting the association is having its own humanoid conference in Tennessee on Oct. 7.

Specialized focus

Instead of replicating the entirety of a human being all at once, humanoid companies have tended to focus on specific parts before moving to others. One of Shenzhen-based Limx Dynamics' products released this year is the P1, a robot for research purposes that can balance on two legs. It can walk up and down stairs, and regain balance when shoved.

Limx Dynamics was founded more than two years ago. Its recent backers include Alibaba, according to PitchBook. The startup earlier this month announced its humanoid could move objects in a warehouse and autonomously replan how to complete a task if the target is moved.

Other companies at the World Robot Conference showed off an array of gears, robot hands and other parts.

Around the year 2030, a single robot will likely be able to perform simple household tasks, nursing care and medical treatment, partly on its own and partly in cooperation with humans, Shigeki Sugano, president of the Robotics Society of Japan, said during the conference forum.

That includes the ability to express emotions, he said. He doesn't expect fully autonomous humanoids until after 2050. Among the development challenges, he said that if a humanoid robot is to support humans fully, then it will need to address the current problem of not having enough power.

A humanoid's battery may only last for two hours before needing to be recharged.

SINGAPORE ANNOUNCED TOP MARITIME CENTRE FOR 11th CONSECUTIVE YEAR

he Baltic Exchange, in collaboration with Xinhua News Agency, announces the release of the 2024 Xinhua-Baltic International Shipping Centre Development Index (ISCDI) Report. This annual report, now in its 11th year, ranks the world's leading shipping centres based on a comprehensive evaluation of port factors, professional business services, and the general environment, the Baltic Exchange said in a media release.

For the 11th consecutive year, Singapore has been recognised as the world's leading shipping centre, achieving a score of 96.23 out of 100.

The enduring success of the island nation is attributed to Singapore's strategic location, robust international outlook, and a well-established ecosystem of professional maritime services.

Baltic Exchange reports

London once again secured second position with a score of 82.50, demonstrating its continued prominence as a maritime support services powerhouse. Shanghai, with a score of 81.84, retained third place, highlighting its significant role as a major port city in Asia. London and Shanghai have retained their positions of second and third place, respectively, within the Index for the past five years.

Hong Kong (79.07) and Dubai (75.64) rounded out the top five, emphasising the strength and importance of these key global shipping hubs. Rotterdam solidified its position as a European leader by maintaining its strong sixth place from 2023 into 2024.

Meanwhile both Athens/Piraeus and Ningbo Zhoushan have each climbed one place in the rankings this year, to seventh and eighth, respectively. As a result, Hamburg has dropped two spots to ninth but still maintains its decade-long position in the top 10.

As in 2023, New York/New Jersey rounded out the top 10 owing to a substantial increase in container volumes, as well as improvements in port infrastructure.

Key findings of the 2024 ISCDI Report:

Top Performers: Singapore, London, and Shanghai continue to lead the rankings, underscoring their global leadership in shipping.

Stability in Rankings:

The top 10 shipping centres have shown little change from the previous year, reflecting the stability and sustained performance of these hubs and the wider maritime industry.

New Entrant:

Tianjin was the only new feature to this year's list, taking 19th position, marking yet another Asian port in the global rankings.

Other notable rankings include Houston at 11th (68.08), Tokyo at

12th (66.60), and Guangzhou at 13th (65.36). These cities continue to demonstrate robust maritime capabilities and significant contributions to global shipping.

The ISCDI Report evaluates a total of 43 maritime locations, considering various port metrics such as cargo throughput, crane count, container berth length, and port draught. It also assesses the presence of professional maritime support businesses, including shipbroking, ship management, ship financing, insurance, and legal services, alongside hull underwriting premiums.

Additionally, the evaluation considers general business environment factors like customs tariffs, the level of electronic government services, and overall logistics performance.

According to this year's ISCDI Report, the average score amongst the top 10 ports is 77.12 out of 100, and 69.98 for the top 20, with the average across the entire 43 rankings standing at 59.13.

Mark Jackson, Chief Executive of the Baltic Exchange, commented: "It has been eleven years since the Baltic Exchange began collaborating with Xinhua News Agency on this Index, and in that time, we have observed significant shifts in global trade patterns. The international shipping industry in 2023 demonstrated remarkable resilience and adaptability, reinforcing its indispensable role as the cornerstone of global trade. Despite facing significant economic slowdowns, geopolitical tensions, and environmental challenges, the sector maintained stability and continued to facilitate the movement of essential goods around the world. This year's rankings highlight the strength of global ports, with Singapore, London, and Shanghai continuing to lead the way, providing world-class services and infrastructure that underpin the industry's success. The shipping industry will continue to face challenges such as decarbonisation and evolving trade routes. However, its inherent resilience and strategic importance will ensure that it remains a critical driver of global economic growth and stability."

Pan Haiping, Chairman of China Economic Information Service, said: "This year's ISCDI Report shows that the world's trade and shipping network underwent some subtle changes in 2023. Even with all the challenges the global shipping industry faced throughout the year, including route challenges in the Panama Canal and the Red Sea, the maritime sector continues to exhibit strong vitality and excellent resilience, driven by global demand for goods. Decarbonisation has also become the consensus in the global shipping industry, while digital technologies such as Al, digital twins, IoT, and automation are constantly empowering the shipping industry and promoting the development of ports to





become more efficient, smarter and more sustainable. An efficient, safe, green and smart future is our expectation for the global shipping industry. We look forward to seeing the world's international maritime centres, particularly those highlighted in our report, playing their part to explore the future development of the shipping industry."

1ST US HYDROGEN-POWERED PASSENGER FERRY OPEN FOR BUSINESS

he Sea Change, a hydrogen-powered passenger ferry, plies the waters of the San Francisco Bay. The ferry is helping demonstrate the possibilities of hydrogen as a lower carbon alternative in the hard-to-abate maritime industry.

The inaugural voyage of the world's first commercial passenger ferry powered entirely by hydrogen fuel cells, with zero direct emissions, made history in July in San Francisco, California. The 75passenger catamaran, aptly named Sea Change, is making short trips between Downtown San Francisco Ferry Terminal and Pier 41, close to the iconic Pier 39. The service is part of a six-month demonstration meant to showcase hydrogen's potential for lower carbon intensity marine transportation.

Why It Matters

The maritime industry accounts for about 3% of all greenhouse gas emissions, according to the U.S. Department of Energy. To put that into perspective, if the industry were its own country, it would be the sixth-highest greenhouse gas emitter in the world.

Hydrogen fuel cells may provide a new opportunity to lower the carbon intensity of marine operations and other heavy-duty applications, because these fuel cells do not emit carbon while the vehicle is in operation.

"As the technology and policies advance, we expect that the use of hydrogen will also grow, specifically in these use cases that are hard to electrify. A strong spirit of partnership will be needed to do this well and to do it at scale." stated Michael Hoban, hydrogen general manager.

How It Works

The Sea Change demonstrates that hydrogen fuel cells can successfully be used on marine vessels. Fuel cells convert chemical

energy from hydrogen and oxygen into electrical energy. They offer lower emissions while operating and never need to be recharged, and their only byproducts are water and heat.

Exploring New Directions

This pilot marks a milestone for hydrogen's use in the marine transportation sector. Sea Change is a real-world, practical example of how the government and the private sector can work together to tackle the many challenges that can come with deploying new technologies.

"Public and private entities came together to demonstrate the commercial viability of hydrogen and increase consumer confidence in it. Chevron is focused on creating a large-scale hydrogen business that builds on our assets, capabilities and relationships." stated Elizabeth Vose, Hydrogen Commercial Advisor.

The Sea Change offers stunning views and a lower carbon transportation alternative for passengers. For the maritime industry, it offers an example of how hydrogen can support lower carbon intensity marine operations.

ship carrying crude oil that caught fire after being attacked in the Red Sea could lead to a severe ecological disaster, the European Union's naval force in the region said.

The Sounion tanker was hit by a series of missiles while sailing through the waterway and suffered a fresh attack.

After the first attack on the tanker earlier in the week its crew was evacuated with assistance from a French naval ship.

At that time the vessel was anchored in international waters, the EU Navy said, however following the fires on board it was reported to be drifting.

fter more than ten years of work and four diplomatic conferences, The International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) is proud to announce that, effective August 22, 2024, we will officially change our status from a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) to an Intergovernmental Organization (IGO).

Based on a Convention ratified or acceded to by 34 States to date, the new status represents a significant victory for multilateralism and ocean governance, marking an important step toward enhancing worldwide safety of navigation, efficiency and protection of the marine environment.

The transition to an Intergovernmental Organization will place IALA in a much stronger position to develop and harmonize Marine Aids to Navigation, as governments will be directly involved in our work. All major decisions will be made by representatives of their governments, who hold credentials from their Head of State, Prime Minister or Minister of Foreign Affairs.

For over six decades, IALA has played a pivotal role in providing standards, recommendations and guidelines for the implementation of significant developments within the maritime sector. The organization's focus on harmonization has never been more crucial, especially to achieve an ambitious digital agenda for the maritime sector.

Key benefits of the status change:

· Enhanced International Cooperation: The new status will facilitate more robust and formalized cooperation with international maritime organizations, governments, and other stakeholders, fostering a unified approach to global maritime navigation safety.

- Strengthened Harmonized Framework: As an IGO, IALA will have increased authority to develop and implement standards, recommendations and guideline ensuring that Marine Aids to Navigation including Vessel Traffic Services are consistent and effective across all member states.
- Improved Resource Allocation: The change will enable better resource allocation and funding opportunities, enhancing the development and maintenance of aids to navigation.
- Greater Global Influence: IALA's new status will amplify its voice and influence in international maritime policy discussions, allowing it to advocate more effectively for the interests of maritime safety and environmental protection.

Francis Zachariae, Secretary-General of IALA: "The transition to an Intergovernmental Organization marks a new chapter in IALA's history. This change will enable us to work even more closely with our members and partners to ensure safe, harmonized and more efficient marine navigation worldwide. I also want to emphasize that in times of conflict and war, the creation of an international organization like IALA, which brings together people from around the world in a spirit of cooperation and compromise, underscores the importance of understanding and mutual respect."

Eric Banel, Director-General for Maritime Affairs, Fisheries and Aguaculture (ministry for the sea), France: "France will now host a new Intergovernmental Organization on its territory. The new IALA will be the third global maritime organization (and the only one in France), alongside the International Maritime Organization and the International Hydrographic Organization. It is undoubtedly a great source of pride for my country as the creation of this new maritime organization represents a significant step for multilateralism and ocean governance."

FUJAIRAH JULY BUNKER SALES RISES TO THE HIGHEST LEVEL IN THREE MONTHS

unker fuel sales at the Middle Eastern hub of Fujairah rose to the highest level in three months in July. Total sales excluding lubricants reached 621,679 m3 in July, according to the latest data from the Fujairah Oil Industry Zone and price reporting agency S&P Global Commodity Insights. The total was down by 5.7% from a year earlier, but up by 1.8% from June's level and the highest since April, Ship & Bunker reported.

July's sales were 3.9% lower than the average seen over the previous 12 months. If Fujairah's sales continued their performance from the first seven months of the year, 2024's total would be 7.71 million mt, up by 3% on the year and the most since

Singapore, the world's largest marine fuels hub, saw conventional and biofuel bunker sales rise by 2.8% on the year and by 9.5% on the month in July.

180 CST VLSFO sales in Fujairah rose by 10.9% on the year to 1,411 m3 in July, 380 CST VLSFO lost 10.5% to 411,366 m3, HSFO jumped by 1.8% to 177,349 m3, MGO sank by 82.6% to 241 m3 and LSMGO advanced by 36.1% to 31,312 m3. HSFO took a 28.5% share of the total market last month, up from 26.4% a year earlier.

Fujairah's average VLSFO price in July was \$624/mt, up by 4% on the month and by 7.5% on the year, according to Ship & Bunker data. Singapore's average VLSFO price in July was \$625/mt, up by 3.6% from June's level and by 6.6% from the level seen a year earlier.

Ship & Bunker's G20-VLSFO Index of average prices across 20 leading bunkering ports gained 2.3% on the month and 5.2% on the year to \$634.50/mt in July.

By leveraging advanced microelectronics and energy-efficient technologies, ODAS can deploy a multitude of sensors on a single device, enhancing their data collection capabilities. Meteorological stations around the world rely on accurate sea conditions and marine environment data to deliver precise weather forecasts and warnings. This information is gathered through a network of Ocean Data Acquisition Systems (ODAS), alongside ship weather observations, coastal radars, and satellites.

Ship weather observations are usually limited to major shipping routes and are not available globally. Additionally, with the increasing demands on ship crews, it has become more challenging for them to consistently report weather conditions and adhere to meteorological schedules.

The quality of data from ships can vary, as vessels often avoid areas with adverse weather where observations are most needed.

Satellite imagery provides a broad view of weather patterns, covering extensive areas. Mariners use this weather information for route planning and ongoing weather monitoring. It enhances navigational safety by helping to avoid hazards such as storms and rough seas, enabling mariners to select the safest routes for their vessels.

Purpose and Functionality

The primary function of an ODAS is to gather real-time data about the maritime environment. This data is transferred every hour to the World Meteorological Organization's (WMO) Global Telecommunications System via a geostationary satellite. Before transmission, the data undergoes rigorous quality checks to ensure accuracy.

This real-time information is essential for various applications, including weather forecasts, ocean current predictions, and wave condition assessments. By providing early warnings about adverse conditions, ODAS helps seafarers navigate safely and make informed decisions.

ODAS can be installed on several structures, each serving as a platform for data collection:

- **✓**Lighthouses
- ✓ Lightvessels

- √Towers
- √Offshore Platforms
- √ Buoys

While ODAS buoys are not navigational aids themselves, they are integrated into the International Association of Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) Maritime Buoyage System. These structures are fixed in geographical position, ensuring consistent data collection from specific locations.

Data Collected

ODAS systems measure a variety of parameters to provide comprehensive insights into the maritime environment:

- ✓ Air Temperature: Measures the ambient temperature at sea level.
- √Atmospheric Pressure at Sea Level: Records the pressure exerted by the atmosphere.
- ✓ Wind Direction: Indicates the direction from which the wind is blowing.
- ✓ Wind Speed Including Gusts: Captures the velocity of the wind and any sudden increases in speed.
- ✓ Sea State: Assesses the condition of the sea surface, including factors like roughness and turbulence.
- ✓Wave Height: Measures the vertical distance between the crests and troughs of waves.
- ✓ Sea Surface Temperature: Records the temperature of the ocean surface

By continuously monitoring these parameters, ODAS provides valuable data that supports weather forecasting, marine navigation, and oceanographic research.
